



Gower College offers course at A Level and GCSE – FREE for asylum seekers. Look through their website and choose the course you are interested in, then call the admissions office for that course. You DO not need to pay the £50 fee but you have to speak to someone by phone to authorise this.

University Scholarships

- Swansea University currently offer one Sanctuary Scholarship for a postgraduate taught masters student. Please do keep an eye on our website for details of the scholarship opening for the next academic session: https://www.swansea.ac.uk/money-campuslife/sanctuary-scholarship/.


Move On Service

Just over half of asylum seekers are granted refugee status. However, they then are given just 28 days to leave asylum accommodation and find housing, employment and means to support themselves.

During this time, homelessness becomes a real possibility. Our Move On Team provides crucial support in this period.

Between 2021-2022 the Move-On service held 2,232 face to face sessions helping **1,296** newly granted applicants and their families.
