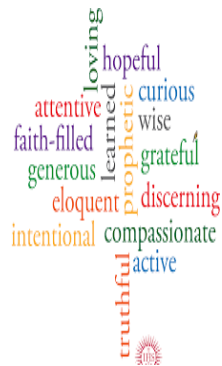
Monday 30th January 2:30pm RWI parent workshop (Rec, Y1 & Y2)

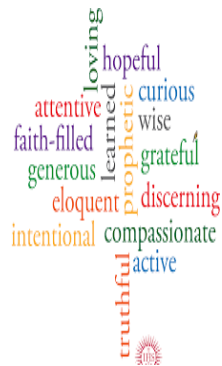
