Manor Adventure – Y6 parent meeting 3rd May 2023

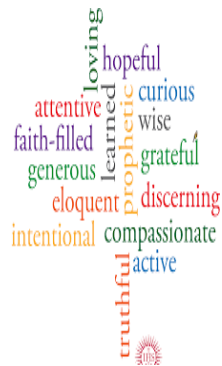

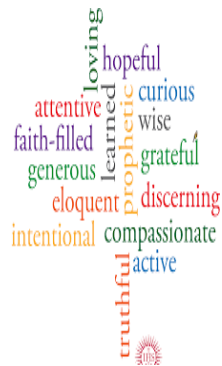
