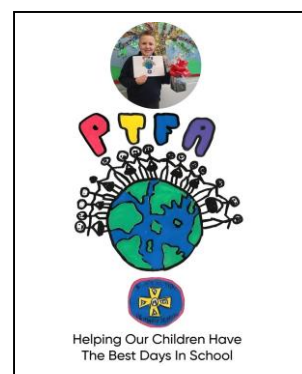

Wraparound

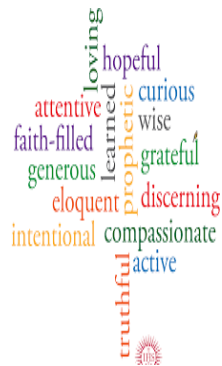
