- Use up balance: Please ensure any remaining balance on sQuid is used up before the end term. If you are still in credit on your sQuid account at the end of term, you will need to request a refund from sQuid directly. Link to the sQuid webpage available here: Contact: sQuid (squidcard.com)
- Automatic Top-up: Ensure you cancel any automatic top-up instructions on sQuid.
- Debt: Clear any debt outstanding on sQuid. Ensure school meals are paid for before they are taken not after.
