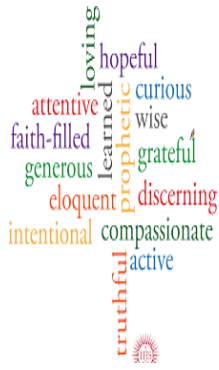
Punctuality is also becoming a concern and all children need to be in school before 8:50am to be ready to learn.

- School tie - only required with blue shirt during summer term

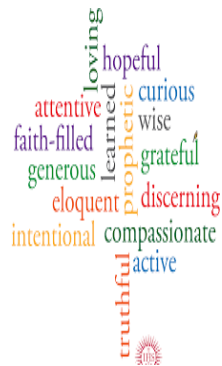
Girls

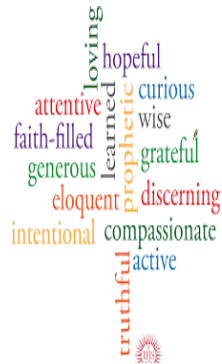
